



SEVENSTAR ROUND BRITAIN AND IRELAND RACE 2022

Notice to Competitors – No 1

There have been a number of questions raised by competitors relating to the course for the Sevensstar Round Britain and Ireland Race. The Race Committee have consolidated correspondence into the following question and subsequent answer;

Question

There appears to be ambiguity regarding the Course as per Notice of Race 9 – Course, that states "The course is around Britain and Ireland (and all outlying islands except Rockall) to Starboard", and the course noted as per Sailing Instruction 15.1 and Addendum B.

The course noted in Addendum B of the Sailing Instructions does not include several outlying rocks such as Flannan Isles, Washerwoman Rock off Great Skelling, the Foze Rocks SW of Tearaght Island & Carrickduff/ Carrickbrown off Black Rock.

Can the Race Committee please clarify the ambiguity created between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions in relation to the course?

Answer

The course as described in the Sailing Instructions as per SI 15 and Addendum B shall be the course sailed by competitors. All islands not explicitly listed in SI Addendum B may be left on either side of the boat.

Therefore, all boats shall only round marks/ islands as listed in the Sailing Instructions. This does not constitute a change to the Notice of Race as per NOR 2.7 – Sailing Instructions
